The TEAL stacks in Gowen and off-site facilities combine to store roughly **271,000 Chinese, 186,000 Japanese and 154,000 volumes of Korean** printed materials, as of 2023.

We also store a sizable collection in other languages, such as **Manchu, Mongolian and Tibetan**. Additionally, various audio visual material, periodicals, graphical materials, and roughly **126,000** e-books are available.

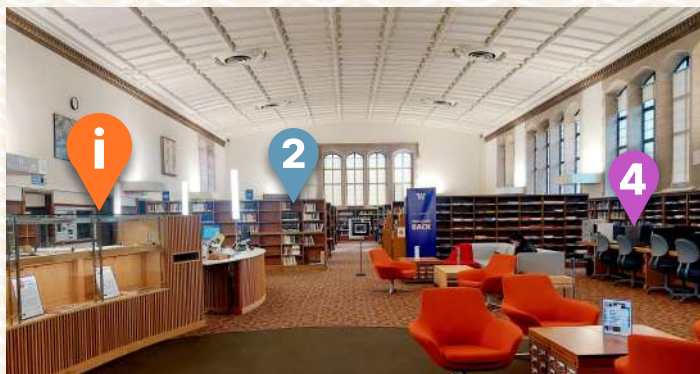

New books are featured on this display for about a month. (Categories: Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Taiwanese)



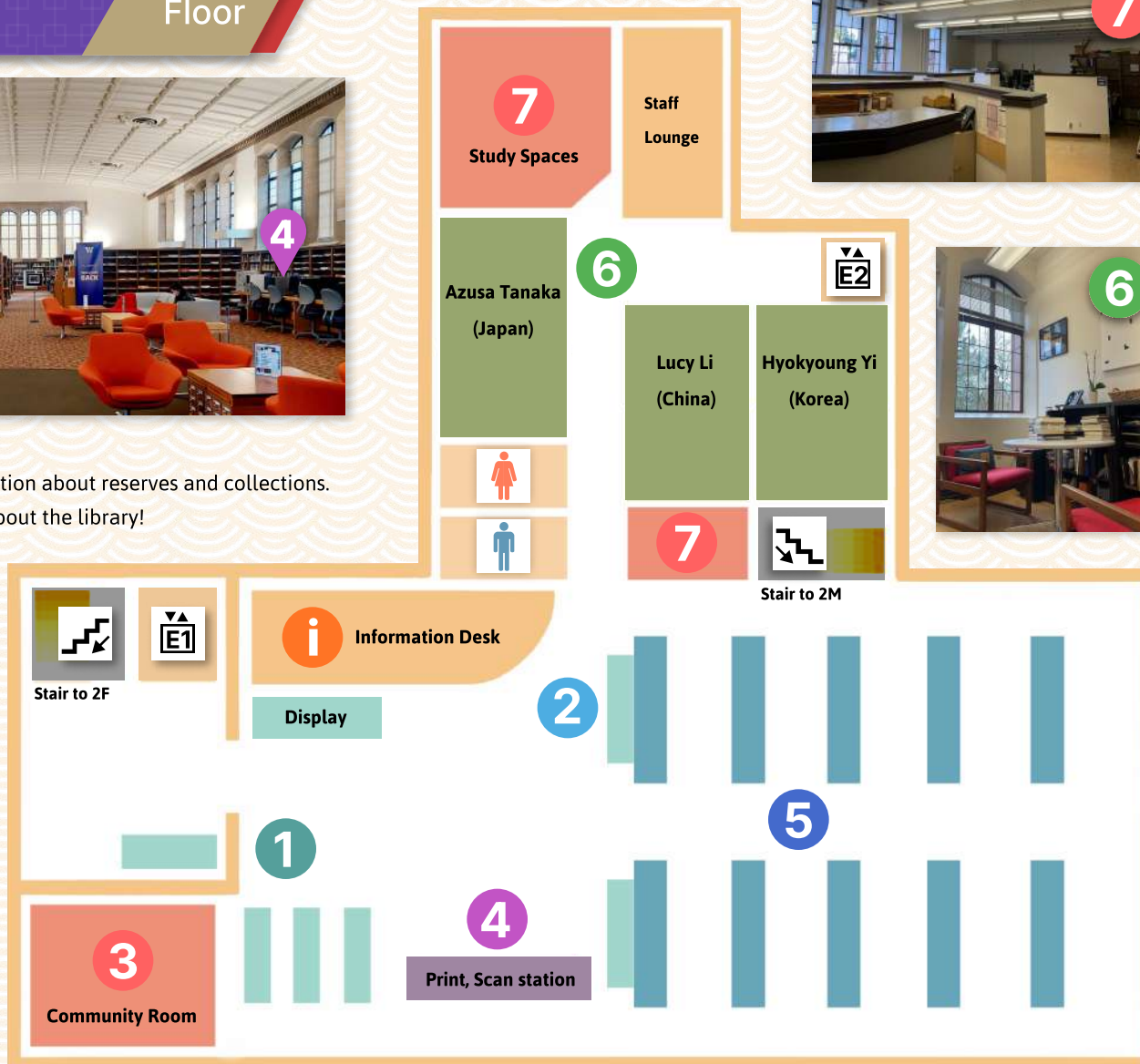
Community Room
